### IT'S EASY WITH SCRIP—TUITION CREDIT

What is scrip you ask? Scrip is a term that means 'substitute money.' When you purchase scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, gas, and other

essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for CCLA. You also earn tuition credit for your family. Each time you buy scrip CCLA gets a certain percentage. We will split that percentage with you and twice a year issue you a tuition credit for that

amount. There are hundreds of vendors to choose from. Go to [www.shopwithscrip.com](http://www.shopwithscrip.com) and check it out. Be sure to watch for the packet coming home with your student. You could be earning BIG money!
